Footnotes

LURE OF THE SOUTH just off the inside towards the rear, came under urging midway on the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch, rallied steadily gaining through the drive to get up inside the final seventy yards and inch away late. JEMARU four wide early on, advanced three wide in the turn to take command nearing the quarter pole, inched away straightened for home to the eighth pole, dug in under a drive, yielded the lead inside the sixteenth marker while holding for the place. GOOD KARMA lunged at the start, settled three wide towards the rear, got placed to encouragement at the three-eighths pole, swung five wide into the stretch, offered up a mild kick to procure the show in the shadow of the wire. MARQUET REBEL saved ground within aim of the front racing in hand, was forced to steady in tight and altered to the two path as RUTHERFORD B, gave way cutting the corner into the stretch, came under urging straightened for the drive, rallied inside into prominence a sixteenth from home to garner the last major share. ADIRONDACK EXPRESS two to three wide in mid pack urged along from three furlongs out, spun three wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild bid but was out kicked to the wire. RUTHERFORD B. on the pace inside racing in hand, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, got displaced on the lead nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch and folded. MR. TOPIA tracked the pace from just off the inside lightly coaxed along, came under a drive at the three-eighths, retreated steadily to the quarter pole and tired in the stretch.
