Footnotes

DOWNTOWN HOTTIE sat well reserved from off the inside during the initial stages, departed the backstretch three wide, picked up interest and rallied into contention, maintained the momentum spinning into the lane and was set down, closed in readily during the ensuing furlong, continued onward until on even terms with the front runners, outkicked them to gain a narrow advantage in deep stretch then just reached the wire in time to fend off the runner up. PISTORIA appeared unsettled while wedged between rivals from about midway down the backstretch until nearly the quarter pole, got asked for a response entering the stretch, altered course a couple of paths to the outside in midlane, found her best stride and had a good finish down the center of the course, needed one more jump. CORRESPONDENT unhurried along the outside for three-quarters, turned for home and was called upon, cut into the leader's margin well enough to reach the eighth pole with only a sliver to make up, soon got hooked up by the first two finishers, fought well but had to settle for the show at the end. LAWLESS MISS fought against the bit, reacting to the grip on the reins being applied by the pilot travelling down the homestretch, had it relaxed slightly and scooted by another pair to take charge, showed the way, rated along primarily from the two path until the quarter pole, reached that station with a significant increase in pressure and was called upon, saw almost all of the advantage gone with a furlong remaining, yielded for good shortly afterwards and steadily backed away. MOLLIE'S PRIZE cut the corner into the lane and had no rally. BLUEGRASS RUMOR forwardly after the start, was put to a firm hold and taken back, advanced towards the front runners under some hand encouragement down the backstretch, until once more put back to a hold and allowed to drop back several lengths during the initial stages of the run around the far turn, was cued up and put to vigorous urging commencing to angle outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was three wide by the top of the lane, made no headway. WE NEED V L T'S three wide on both turns, trailed.
