PEGASUS DIAMOND got involved in three-way tussle with the runner up and IBID nearly from the get-go, was forced to do battle from between them, was put to some hand urging to keep pace around the five-sixteenths marker, had the fight spill over into the lane with a fresher challenger in the form of SHARON SPAGETTI lurking a danger outside the threesome at this juncture, fought onward through the furlong grounds with IBID starting to fall back slightly by the eighth pole, forged on ahead, head to head with the second place finisher and got the job done. YOUR TIME IS UP came away from the gate well, was the outermost of three disputing the pace until midstretch, at times appearing to possess the slimmest of advantages, continued on gamely to the wire, but fell short. WHITE CRANE off the inside, was placed five wide in upper stretch, closed in willingly en route for the show. EASY ENDING put to some hand encouragement leaving the starting gate, never made it out the back of the pack, tucked along the rail well before reaching the end of the backstretch, stayed there for nearly a half, got fanned six wide, the widest of all into upper stretch, was straightened away and came home with good, but belated energy. SHARON SPAGETTI raced towards the inside while keeping watch on a multi-member pace dispute, quickened leaving the three-eighths pole, got angled outward, eventually turning for home four wide, flattened out. DAISYSGONNAMAKEIT stacked five wide at the half mile pole, remained along the overland route on the turn and gave way. IBID argued for control from the rail with another pair until deep into the furlong grounds before faltering. FROSTY BUT FUNKY four wide departing the backstretch, tired.
