### Footnotes

JEALOUS secured a forward position after the start, departed the backstretch three wide and stayed out in that path before settling closer to the inside midpoint on the turn, was let out a notch and steadily advanced towards the leader late on the turn, challenged turning for home, took over quickly and drew off. BONITA SONATA between rivals at the half mile pole, improved position during the run around the bend, proved no match for the top one while comfortably in front of the others for the place. OUR DAY IN COURT swung four wide into upper stretch and rallied for the show. MEA MAXIMA CULPA guided over to the rail at the end of the backstretch, was under a drive a furlong later, made no headway and tired. MCGILLYCUDDY'S GAL three wide at the half mile pole, was no factor. MS. TRUE WAY kicked clear of the rest during the initial stages and tucked along the inside, came under pressure for the first time nearing the quarter pole, was let out but succumbed in short order nonetheless. LEHIGH LASS along the inside, was never in contention. DIXIE SPARKLE darted over to the two path after the start, gave way. PATTONESQUE briefly along the inside on the turn, drifted five to six wide into upper stretch while tiring.
