RUBY RUBLES showed good speed from the outside, soon opened a clear lead, set the pace, drew away on the turn, settled into the stretch with a sizeable advantage and remained clear under a drive. UP WE GO bobbled at the start, was unhurried while outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. GO TO THE INK raced close up while well in hand, put in a run on the turn but could not close in on the winner and weakened in the final furlong. BIOGIO'S ROSE was rated along inside, advanced inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and lacked a serious closing kick. LA VILLE ROUGE raced within striking distance on the backstretch, came three wide nearing the stretch and had no response when roused. OH WHAT A WINDFALL raced between rivals and tired in the stretch. LURICON raced three wide and tired.
