CLASSICAL FASHION away well, had control established a short distance from the gate, set honest fractions taking the inside route and with no real opposition in sight for nearly three-quarters, shook off a feeble challenge coming to the quarter pole, extended out to a comfortable margin during the ensuing furlong, having now been asked for some run and was kept busy to maintain it. GREAT GRACIE DANE judiciously rode the rail around the first bend, was eased into the two path early down the backstretch, made slow, but steady progress the remainder of the way along the backstretch, picked up ground more readily on the far turn, under some urging, took her best shot at the top one leaving the five-sixteenths pole, but wasn't able to keep pace. SOTIQUE three wide around the opening bend, settled a bit closer to the inside upon reaching the backstretch, bided time, well reserved towards the back of the pack, swung three wide for the stretch run and rallied mildly to secure the show. DOPKE GAL tucked along the inside leaving the first turn, contently rode the rail, cut the corner into the lane under encouragement and improved position, while never posing a threat to the winner. MAMBO FEVER was grabbed hold after rubbing the right side of the starting gate, moved up willingly, settled into midpack and raced three wide on the first turn, continued along unhurried for the initial six furlongs, was roused entering the stretch but lacked the needed response. SING MY SONG three wide departing the backstretch, issued an abbreviated challenge for command approaching the quarter pole, that soon fizzled out. JOYCE'S ANGEL saved ground until the quarter pole to no avail. LAURASIA loosely prompted the pacesetter from the outside and folded.
