ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS broke alertly and maintained the momentum to grab a good forward position, vied for the lead from the two path during the early going, shook free with a sudden move coming to the half mile pole, continued to set pace, slightly off the inside, loosely-contested and with the rider trying to hold something back, was given his cue in upper stretch and reacted positively, still held a comfortable advantage with an eighth to go and showed good determination under steady encouragement to fend off the sole stretch threat and preserve the decision. MOON RAVEN left the backstretch four wide, was asked for a response in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and came up with one, finishing willingly to garner place honors. WISHFUL TOMCAT three wide at the half mile pole, got out finished. ROYAL MAJESTY contested the pace from the inside for about a half, was guided over into the two path after being shooed away, continued to stalk the front runner, was asked for run on the turn to keep pace, steadily tired after going three-quarters. SUMMER SHARE raced along the outside and was no factor. GOODBYEANDGOODLUCK was taken three wide midway on the turn in preparation for the stretch drive, but had no offering after being called upon. GOOD LAW was coaxed along while taking the inside route around the turn, and failed to menace. RAFFINATOR saved ground, was angled outward a short distance from the quarter pole, failed to fire.
