**Footnotes**

MARKET DISTORTION patiently stalked the front runners while placed in the two path, was asked to pick it up in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home and commenced to rally in earnest three wide at the head of the stretch, closed in gradually throughout the stretch run, apparently getting the head down in time at the finish line to prevail. FUGEDABOUDIT SANDY assumed a forward position soon after the start, started the run around the far turn three wide, ranged up closer to the leader, splitting rivals midway on the turn, when CAP THE MOMENT ventured out into the overland route, bid for command nearing the quarter pole, fought his way to the front with an eighth to go, dug in stubbornly when the winner drew abreast but got nailed on the line. SEATTLE LOUIE disputed the pace towards the three path, overhauled the pacesetter to grab a narrow lead at the quarter pole, relinquished it after sparring with the runner up during the next furlong and steadily weakened thereafter. SMOOTH TRANSITION came three wide into the lane and improved position. CAP THE MOMENT well off the inside on the turn, drifted widest of the front runners into the stretch and gave way. ACTLIKEYOUMEANIT guided quickly to the inside, failed to reach a contending position. BRUNELLI slipped off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, but came up empty for the stretch run. FIRST DAY vied for command towards the two path for six furlongs and wilted.
