Footnotes

WARRIOR UP tucked along the rail in the initial stages, took the inside route around the opening bend before eased outward soon after settling into the backstretch, sat reserved within range in the two path until the half mile pole, was asked to pick up interest on the far turn, turned for home four wide under a drive, gained readily on the leader, wrested away the lead a few strides past the furlong grounds and edged clear, driving. OUR ELI cut the pace along the inside, was set down entering the stretch, tried unsuccessfully to turn back the top one but continued with good energy to procure the place. FAST GRIEVANCE lagged behind riding the rail, steadily advanced after departing the backstretch, was taken outward at the five-sixteenths pole, beginning a long maneuver to the outside for the stretch run which eventually took him to the five path at the top of the lane, got straightened away and came home willingly to grab the show. A ROD prompted the pacesetter from the outside, was urged on the second turn to remain in close attendance, tired steadily after turning for home. OUT OF YOUR MIND saved ground and had no rally. UNFORGETTABLE P J took the inside route and went on to improve position by mainly weak and tired ones in the lane. FORTY TEARS between rivals for most of the running on the second turn, failed to muster up the needed closing punch. SAM HILLIC broke inward, bumping soundly with NUB THROWER, was strung out four wide on the opening bend, hit the backstretch and accelerated towards the leader to assume the role of stalker, stayed within striking distance three wide around the subsequent turn for six furlongs and folded. OASIS OF CHANCE seemed to have trouble handling the first turn, eventually winding up being the widest of the field for a period of time, was never in contention. NUB THROWER bobbed after making contact with SAM HILLIC leaving the gate, raced three wide and was through after going six furlongs.
