STORMY'S MAJESTY patiently stalked the leader from the outside, continued to bide time for nearly three-quarters, moved when ready coming to the quarter pole, confidently went by a sixteenth down the road, then was put to stronger hand encouragement leaving the eighth pole to prevail over a gritty MINE OVER MATTER. MINE OVER MATTER placed under a firm hold soon after the start, tracked the leader from the pocket, found wiggle space leaving the five-sixteenths pole to ease outward, angled three wide rather than attempt to squeeze through a narrow space between the front runners, was roused after entering the stretch, continued onward with good courage but had to settle for being second best. JOHANNESBURG SMILE rated inside through the opening half, was asked for some run midway on the turn, came under assault from the top one nearing the head of the stretch, failed to stave that opponent despite having put to a drive and weakened steadily thereafter. SLEVIN raced along the outside, was urged on the turn but failed to threaten. SIX FLINGS three wide, was set down at the five-sixteenths pole and offered no response. JOE CORRIGAN saved ground to no avail.
