SING LIKE A BIRD set the pace just off the inside in the two path under some pressure to her outside, came under coaxing near the five-sixteenths when challenged by her prompter heading to the top of the lane, was set down at the quarter pole, turned back her only challenge going clear under a drive. BANDINI'S DIAMOND broke sharply, prompted the pace from the three path, was placed to hand urging midway on the turn to issue a challenge at the head of the stretch, was let out at that station, was repelled at that juncture, no match for the top one while garnering place honors safely. LUMINEUSE outrun in the early going, chased the pace from afar while saving ground, cut the corner into the lane under a drive, displayed a good kick along the inside to be well clear for show honors. SWEET KAKES chased the pace from four wide through the turn, came under a prolonged drive from the three-eighths pole and offered no kick. MAD FAST dwelt at the start and was off four lengths slow as a result, came under hustling to get involved from the seven-sixteenths and tired.
