FRESHMAN DORM settled early, moved out on the backstretch, rallied three wide on the turn, exchanged brushes with the runner-up in upper stretch, battled heads apart inside the eighth pole then finished determinedly to prevail after a long drive. FINANCIALLY SECURE was under a firm hold early while tucking in behind the leaders, waited in hand along the rail on the turn, brushed with the winner while trying to get out in upper stretch, split rivals to challenge in midstretch, put a head in front in deep stretch and was nipped in the final strides. MYSTIC FEVER pressed the pace from outside, gain a slim lead in upper stretch, battled into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. UPPER AFLEET saved ground to the turn, angled out in upper stretch and rallied mildly. STONES THROW set the pace on the rail into upper stretch and gave way. FORTY PRAYERS failed to mount a serious rally. FLAG INDY trailed throughout.
