AL'S LARK sat within range in the two path for nearly a half, moved up in preparation for the stretch run as the field approached the quarter pole, took off in earnest after being let out, gradually closed in on the leader, collared that rival at the sixteenth pole and edged clear, driving. RAMPANT slow to settle leaving the gate, began to pick up interest after the second tap on the right shoulder, was placed in the two path for the run around the bend, however, remained well back, angled three wide into the stretch, kicked in after being straightened away, and had a good finish down the middle of the strip to garner place honors. SURFING IAN broke alertly and went on to dispute the pace from the outside, bumped lightly with SAINTS ALIVE in the vicinity of the nine-sixteenths pole, with both horses, slipping and sliding a bit over the sloppy going, shook off the previously mentioned rival a short time later, continued to show the way, deliberately keeping some distance off the inside, turned for home under encouragement, offered some resistance before yielding with about a sixteenth remaining and eventually weakened into the show slot. LITTLE WISE GUY worked out a tuck along the rail at the half mile pole only to vacate the inside route only a sixteenth down the road, angled three wide into the stretch but lacked the needed response. SAINTS ALIVE vied for the lead along the inside, bumped lightly with SURFING IAN down the backstretch, began losing contact with that rival leaving the half mile pole and faltered. FAYOUM raced along the outside and failed to reach a contending position. COACH FRUSCIO saved ground to no avail. YOU BETTER BELIEVE hustled from the gate, raced three wide and folded. An objection lodged by the rider of SAINTS ALIVE against the rider of SURFING IAN alleging interference early down the backstretch was dismissed.
