### Footnotes

MERLIN BAY the last to pop out of the starting gate, lumbered along in the back of the pack down the chute, picked up speed and interest after entering the backstretch, steadily advanced in the right direction during the run around the bend, angled outward under strong encouragement into upper stretch, settled into the five path after completing the maneuver, got rolling nearing the eighth pole, powered by COLIE Z to take charge and drew clear. COLIE Z established command soon after the start, showed the way, placed in the two path and being coaxed along, was let out after entering the stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds still holding a comfortable advantage but with the top one bearing down hard and fast, readily yielded to that one but continued on willingly enough to hold on to second. FEROCIOUS WON left the backstretch from the four path, was asked to pick up the pace soon afterwards, closed in gradually, held his striking position until midstretch then got out finished. MARINA MARKET accompanied the pacesetter from the three path for six furlongs and folded. MONTE raced along the outside, was set down in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. STEALTH MISSILE well off the inside, was outrun. BON MARIE moved up in steady fashion towards the inside before flattening out by midpoint on the turn. INCREDIBLE SPEED offered little.
