SWEET SARANNA assumed a forward position leaving the gate, disputed the pace with JILLY WILLY glued alongside to her left, raced as a team with only a sliver of daylight separating the twosome down the backstretch and around the bend, began to edge away soon after entering the stretch, having now been asked for a response, then dug in well enough to stave off a fast-closing rival to preserve the decision. PAGE BY PAGE was bumped between rivals at the start, recovered in short order and settled near the back of the pack, placed off the inside, was put to encouragement early on the turn, swung five for the stretch run, accelerated impressively leaving the eighth pole, flying home belatedly to grab the place award. SUPERIOR SARAH was bumped twice in two separate incidences at the start, was kept on proper stride and moved up to midpack, left the backstretch from the three path, stayed within range, anxiously tossing her head back and forth at various points during the run around the bend, turned for home, still well off the inside and was given her cue, responded professionally being pulled off an errant HOLY SPICE, twice avoiding any real contact with that drifting opponent, from between the three-sixteenths pole to the eighth pole, and although out finished by top twosome, still finished willingly to earn the show. TIZLING coaxed tracking the pacesetter from the inside, flattened out. SARAH'S PLEASURE bumped at the start, took the inside route and lacked the necessary stretch response. HOLY SPICE reserved three wide, was hand urged to reach a good striking position by the quarter pole only to soon flatten out. JILLY WILLY broke alertly and dashed towards the inside, fought for the lead for a half and gave way. PRAYFORSRING careened to well out in the track after bumping with SUPERIOR SARAH a couple of jumps leaving the gate, remained unhurried, well outside until angling into the two path by the half mile pole, failed to menace thereafter.
