ADIOS CHARLIE broke on top and held his forward position, pressed the leader, flanked just to that opponent's outside, was joined by JUSTIN PHILLIP departing the backstretch, vied for command, between rivals from the seven-sixteenths pole to the three-sixteenths pole, was seemingly shaken off with a furlong remaining, but came again under strong handling, wrested away the lead from JUSTIN PHILLIP in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away, being kept to the task at hand. ASTROLOGY coaxed almost from the get-go, sat parked in the two path, continued along on the same scenario for nearly five furlongs, was asked to pick up the pace coming to the five-sixteenths pole, but made little headway, swung three wide into the lane under a full drive, still made little progress on the front runners, then continued onward in the final furlong to be along in the final strides to gain the place. JUSTIN PHILLIP was grabbed hold after the winner came in slightly leaving the starting gate, advanced to midpack under his own power, left the backstretch four wide and sat perched from there, moved up, still under his own courage to vie for the lead, contested the pace, the outermost member of a threesome, turned for home, nearly a length in front, was roused soon after entering the stretch, remained under a strong drive leaving the furlong grounds, but wasn't able to hold off the top one, relinquished with a sixteenth remaining and went on to get out finished for place honors as well. RATTLESNAKE BRIDGE three wide around the turn, lacked the necessary stretch response. ISN'T HE PERFECT was taken to the inside soon after the start, took the inside route until the quarter pole, angled outward gradually during the ensuing sixteenth but failed to have a serious impact on the outcome. STARSHIP CAESAR three wide around the turn, was never a threat. GALLANT DREAMS raced along the outside and had no rally. CAL NATION grabbed the lead soon after the start, showed the way, well out in the track down the backstretch, was taken over to the two path in time for the run around the bend, vied for command, with another pair of rivals until upper stretch and backed away.
