HURRICANE HEAT was well placed just off the early pace, saved ground through the turn, angled out, challenged in midstretch and prevailed after a long drive. LEMON SHORE set a pressured pace the entire way and yielded grudgingly. UNGI BLANC was a bit rank early, rallied on the rail leaving the turn and finished willingly to gain a share. MEDJOOOL was outrun to the turn and rallied belatedly on the rail. ALY'S WHEAT raced evenly while three wide. FERENTZ was outrun after breaking slowly. HE AINT EASY chased four wide to the turn and faded. PAVLOV'S DOG pressed the pace from outside for six furlongs and gave way. MATTHEW T C raced in midpack while three wide and faltered on the far turn.
