**Footnotes**

REVEALING MOMENT came away awkwardly, after appearing to make some contact with the left side of the starting gate, had the pilot lose his balance and come out of both irons, was almost a quarter into the contest before successfully back in each of them, began the run around the bend from near the two path, commenced to get angled outward leaving the five-sixteenths marker, completed the maneuver being four wide, took over the lead in the final furlong and kicked away. PURLING tracked the pace at or near the inside, altered course to the outside in midstretch and rallied willingly enough to garner the place. LITTLE GABBY GIRL took command after leaving the gate, despite getting bumped, settled near the inside, cut the pace while being rated along, got set down in upper stretch, relinquished to the top one and weakened steadily in the final furlong. HIGH INFLATION got bumped from between rivals at the break, was three wide at the three-eighths pole, lacked the needed response. START IT UP chased the pacesetter from the two path, gave way. GLASSY ALY made contact with HIGH INFLATION leaving the gate, worked out a tuck along the rail past the half mile pole, rode it for the rest of the way on the turn, got put to encouragement angling out for the drive home, made no headway. HEIDI'S HOLIDAY in the three path midpoint on the turn, trailed.
