ANTHENIAN'S LEGACY set the pace along the inside and stayed on gamely on the rail. GOING AWAY BLUES raced with the pace while between rivals and weakened in the final furlong. DOUBLECOMET was steadied along the inside leaving the backstretch, rallied wide and finished well outside. PIP PIP HURRAY had no rally. RED TEES was outrun. WORLSIGOLD raced inside and tired.
