Footnotes

MISTER NOBODY sprinted clear on the rail, opened a comfortable advantage in upper stretch and drew away under steady left hand urging. REGAL OFFICER trailed for five furlongs, saved ground through the turn and finished willingly. FREGATA was reserved for a half after being bumped at the start, raced between horses on the turn and lacked a rally. RUNNING HOT rushed up between horses after breaking slowly and being bumped at the start, lodged a bid outside the winner nearing the quarter pole and gradually tired thereafter. SAINT BARR bumped at the start, steadied along the inside in the early stages, saved ground to the top of the stretch and tired. HALF A NOTE raced four wide throughout and drifted out while giving way in midstretch.
