DIVINE PARK showed good speed along the inside, contested the pace, responded when roused turning for home, drew clear and remained clear under a drive. C P WEST raced in hand early while between rivals, came wide into the stretch and finished well outside. FROSTY SECRET raced with the pace along the inside while in hand, put in a run on the rail entering the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MINT SLEWLEP was rated along outside, raced three wide and offered a mild rally outside. STREET MAGICIAN contested the pace while between rivals and tired in the final furlong. OUR SACRED HONOR chased the pace while four wide and tired in the stretch. BRISCO N LOGAN contested the pace while three wide and tired after a half mile.
