AZTEC PEARL was outrun early, rallied inside and finished gamely while being bumped in deep stretch. PRIMA GREEN was outrun early, raced inside, encountered traffic problems in the stretch and finished gamely while being bumped in deep stretch. MIZ LYNNE KELLY was rated along early, came wide for the drive and finished well outside. SOUNDS FISHY chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. HOTTENTOT chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. LA FONTAINIERE (IRE) raced four wide and tired in the stretch. REBELANO had no rally.
