I MET SOMEBODY was rated along inside, rallied inside nearing the stretch and drew clear under a drive. LADY GWEN was outrun early, raced inside, angled out in upper stretch and finished gamely while between rivals. GIVE AND TAKE raced outside early on, rallied three wide on the second turn and finished well outside. COVINCING was unhurried early, put in a run along the inside on the second turn and weakened late. BIG TEASE was unprepared for the start, was away behind the field, put in a three wide run on the second turn and weakened in the final furlong. BUTTERFACE quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace and tired in the stretch. SHOOT THE WAD chased the pace and tired.
