HEY HEY SUNNY was unhurried early on, rallied four wide on the turn, finished gamely from the outside and was driving under the wire. TOAST N' JAM set the pace along the inside and dug in gamely through the stretch. POET'S LADY raced between rivals early and finished well outside. DEVIL'S FIDDLER chased the pace while three wide and lacked a rally. RHYTHMICAL LADY raced with the pace and was steadied in deep stretch. PERCHED HIGH was outrun early, came wide for the drive and had no rally. JOVIAL CHARADE raced inside and had no rally. DOUBLEYOURPLEASURE chased inside and tired in the stretch.
