CANDYBEDANDY quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace and drew away under a vigorous hand ride. BELLES LETTRES was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished well to get the place prize. O'CAT chased the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. COZY CAY was unhurried early, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. MRS. COOLIDGE was outrun early, put in a three wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. MARY GOODNIGHT raced inside and had no rally. ITALIANA was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. ARMOURETTE raced three wide and tired. LIFTING THE VEIL tired after an inside trip. HOT DANCER chased the pace while three wide and tired.
