STRATEGIC MISSION set the pace along the inside while in hand, drew clear when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. PINE DANCE was rated along early, rallied along the inside turning for home and finished gamely but could not get to the winner. LEGAL JOUSTING (IRE) raced close up inside while under wraps and stayed on well through the stretch. SLOWHAND raced close up while three wide and lacked a solid finishing kick. GATEMAN (GB) prompted the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. COMPANY APPROVAL was rated outside and had no response when roused. RUMSONONTRIVER was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. BUDDHA'S DELIGHT had no response when roused. COUNTRY BE GOLD raced inside and had no rally.
