RICHLY BLENDED contested the pace from the outside, responded when roused, drew away in upper stretch and was kept to a drive to the finish. LE GRANDE DANSEUR ducked out at the start, was steadied, raced inside and finished gamely on the rail. TELES CAM was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. SAM LORD'S CASTLE was pinched between rivals at the start, raced close up outside early, put in a three wide run nearing the stretch and faded in the final furlong. REGAL SHIVERS was hustled along inside, came wide into the stretch and had no response when roused. TOUR OF THE CAT was hustled along while three wide and tired in the stretch. SKIP TO THE STONE contested the pace along the inside and tired after three quarters.
