APRIL'S BENEFIT, rated along inside, advanced on the second turn, came wide approaching the stretch, responded when roused and drew clear late under a drive. TIMEISOFTHEESSENCE pressed the pace while between rivals and stayed on gamely to the finish. HOLY BOLLA set the pace along the inside and stayed on gamely through the stretch. ARCTIC GOLD, rated along between rivals, rallied on the rail nearing the stretch but lacked a solid finishing punch. SISKEL chased the pace while three wide on both turns and tired. MAID OF SILVER, outrun early, came wide for the drive but had no rally. MINING CALSKEY raced wide throughout and tired. BYCARBY was unprepared for the start and off in a tangle.
