BIG E E was bumped after the start, was rated along outside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, lugged in in the drive but finished gamely to be clear late under a drive. PRECISE END broke awkwardly but quickly showed in front, posted strong fractions, settled into the stretch with a clear lead and stayed on gamely but could not withstand the winner. PORT HERMAN showed good speed from the outside, chased the pace into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CAT'S AT HOME chased the pace along the inside, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. BULLING was bumped at the start and outrun early, raced three wide on the turn and had no rally. TURNOFTHECENTURY stumbled after the start, was bumped, chased the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch. BARE OUTLINE chased along the inside and tired after a half mile. BE MINE TONIGHT hit the gate at the start, was bumped after the start and tired.
