FASHION SENSE was rated along inside, saved ground, altered course for running room in midstretch and finished gamely outside. MONTEFIORE raced close up inside, came wide for the drive, lugged in the stretch and tired. FORMAL DANCER chased the pace from the outside and had no rally. DINAH'S PEARLS raced close up while wide throughout and tired in the stretch. QUIET JULIA raced in hand early, advanced on the second turn, was steadied when put in tight quarters in the stretch, was bumped and tired. HEIR TO THE QUEEN raced wide and had no rally. AWESOME GAL stumbled after the start and had no rally. DANCE LEAD set the pace along the inside, was bumped in the stretch, stumbled, was steadied and tired. NORWOODS tired.
