BORSHOI BALLET, rated along outside, advanced four wide on the second turn, reached the front nearing the eighth pole then dug in gamely and prevailed under a drive. SUMMER MIST, rated outside, rallied wide and finished gamely from the outside. LADY BOGIE prompted the pace from the outside and stayed on gamely through the stretch. WILDINTHEFIELDS, rated between rivals, stayed on well inside. RED LODGE, rated inside, put in a run along the inside on the second turn but lacked a solid finishing kick. WOLLAPALOOZA, rated along inside, had no rally. PLENTY OF LUCK broke slowly and had no rally. LURICON chased three wide and tired. JAGUAR JOYCE set the pace and tired after three quarters. YAMILA'S JEWELS chased inside and tired.
