VOLKONSKY argued the pace along the inside, dug in gamely when roused for the drive and drew clear late, driving. D' COACH was rated along inside, angled out and rallied three wide nearing the stretch, could not get by the winner and continued on to hold the place spot. DR. ROCKETT was outrun early, put in a prolonged four wide rally and finished well outside. COLONIAL BOY argued the pace from the outside and weakened in the stretch. SEEKING A DREAM raced inside and had no rally. GOLDEN SLEW raced wide throughout and had no response when roused. SINGLE RAINBOW chased the pace while three wide and tired. ACTUARY'S SON raced between rivals and tired.
