DYNAMIC FEATURE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch, finished fast outside and was up in time, driving. PHILOMELA was rated along early, rallied into the stretch, gained the lead in deep stretch and dug in gamely but could not hold off the winner. A BIT OF PRESSURE raced close up along the

inside, rallied into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SKY was rated along between rivals, angled out and put in a three wide run approaching the stretch and tired in deep stretch. SORORITY WILDCAT was rated along early, put in a run along the inside on the second turn and faded in the final furlong. CRISTINA'S DIAMOND was in hand early, raced inside and had no rally. SPARTAN VALOR was outrun early, rallied inside on the second turn and was steadied repeatedly when buried in traffic along the inside in the stretch. UNTUTTABLE GAL was outrun early, put in a four wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. FREAKIN' OUT set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. EXPIRATION DAY chased the pace and tired after three quarters. ACT AS IF raced close up while three wide, was steadied on the second turn and tired. DIXIE BRIDGE raced four wide, was steadied on the second turn and tired.
