


EARLY WARNING quickly established himself on the lead, controlled the pace while in hand, drew away when roused turning for home and remained safely clear while being shown the whip to the finish. DEPUTY DIAMOND raced close up outside while in hand, advanced on the second turn but proved no match for the winner while clearly second best. GULLIVER raced close up along the rail while in hand, saved ground into the stretch but could not stay with the top two. COMIC STRIP, outrun early, was angled to the outside on the backstretch, raced wide into the stretch but lacked a solid finishing kick. WATCH THE BIRD, rated along inside, came wide for the drive but had no rally. A FLEETS DANCER chased the pace from the outside, raced wide on both turns and tired in the stretch. SIR TIFF attended the pace from the outside while in hand and retired after the opening three quarters. JESS M dropped back and had no response when roused.
