**Footnotes**

JET BLACK, with the pace while in hand, took over and drew clear turning for home then widened under a drive. ARCTIC GOLD came in on the backstretch, bumping TRUTH VALUE into BUSHMILL, then raced wide and stayed gamely. SKYWICK, outrun early, finished well. TRUTH VALUE, bumped on the backstretch, contested the pace while between rivals and faded in the stretch. SHAVAMIRA chased the pace and lacked a rally. COLD STARE, never far back, put in a run along the inside on the turn but had nothing left for the stretch drive. BURNSHIRE was steadied on the turn and again in the stretch. ASLEEP IN SEATTLE had no response. BUSHMILL was taken up from between rivals on the backstretch then raced wide. ELFIN GLEN had no response. BIRDIE'S SISTER raced inside and was taken up severely along the rail in the stretch. PLATNIUM CARD was hustled up to set the pace then tired badly. Following a claim of foul by the rider of the fourth place finisher against the second place finisher on the backstretch; ARCTIC GOLD was disqualified and placed ninth for initiating a chain reaction on the backstretch.
