TAYGETA STORM showed good speed from the outside, drew clear into the turn, took a clear lead past the eighth pole and continued on gamely to the wire. CERTAIN PHONE raced three wide and had no response when roused. DIABLOS LYRIC LADY raced four wide and lacked a rally. MARGIN FOR ERROR raced inside and had no rally. SALTY KRISSY was hustled from the start but had no response. MORGAN LEWIS showed brief speed on the rail and tired.
