CLASSIC MOON was well placed, closed the gap three wide on the turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch and drew clear under right hand urging. U. S. CAVALRY set the pace in the two path into midstretch and yielded to the winner while holding well for the place. RUFF AND READY saved ground while gaining on the turn, swung out in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. HEDGE FUND rushed up along the rail after breaking slowly, battled along the inside for a half and weakened. ZIP TO THE CITY was outrun for a half after checking at the start and rallied mildly between horses. DARK CHEETAH chased three wide to the turn and lacked a late response. KAMBOOS MAN pressed three wide for a half and tired. BENLAYLA failed to threaten while racing wide. MAVEN saved ground to no avail. REMORSE dropped back nearing the far turn and was never close thereafter.
