SAGINAW sprinted clear on the rail, raced uncontested on the front and drew off in hand. BRAZEN KAT chased the winner to the turn but was no match while clearly second best. LOVE AND HAVOC gained inside on the turn and improved his position late. MONASTIR raced just off the pace three wide for five furlongs and faded. TITLETOWN TIGER failed to mount a serious rally. MIND BOGGING raced in midpack and lacked a rally. TALKING BLUES failed to menace. ADMIRAL CAPERTON showed only brief speed. NUGGET OF WISDOM was outrun after breaking slowly. NAVAJO SPIRIT never reached contention.
