### Footnotes

DOUBLY DEVIOUS, in hand outside in the early going, advanced three wide on the second turn, responded when set down entering the stretch, reached the front leaving the eighth pole and prevailed under a drive. CERIDWEN, rated along early, rallied four wide on the second turn and finished gamely from the outside. LADIES NIGHT IN showed good speed while well in hand, took over from pacesetter SUGARKEY nearing the stretch and stayed on gamely to the finish. RED KNICKERS, rated inside, was caught in traffic along the inside on the second turn and finished well once clear. VERI TERRI, outrun early, raced inside into the stretch, altered close to the outside in upper stretch and finished well. RUN ALEXIS RUN, close up inside early on, put in a good run along the inside on the second turn but could not sustain that bid. SOME IRISH LEGEND, rated along early, raced between rivals and lacked a rally. JOVIAL CHARADE had no response when roused. NEW YORK GHAZETTE was outrun. SUGARKEY set the pace and gave way after three quarters.
