DURING raced with the pace while in hand, dug in gamely when roused and prevailed after a long drive. UNFORGETTABLE MAX raced with the pace while three wide and stayed on gamely outside. INAMORATO was unhurried early on, rallied three wide on the second turn and finished gamely outside. CONGRATS raced between rivals early, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. NEWFOUNDLAND was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. CONSERVATION was outrun early, came wide for the drive and had no rally. COLITA was outrun early, had no response when roused and tired. SHARP IMPACT was hustled to the front, set the pace, stopped after three quarters and was eased in the stretch.
