ORDERLY stalked the pacesetter while travelling in the three path, advanced when ready nearing the top of the stretch, had no trouble taking charge upon hitting the quarter pole, lengthened out to a sizeable advantage with a furlong remaining, then maintained it while being kept busy. BUDDHA POWER tracked the leader while taking the inside route, swung out heading for the top of the stretch, proved to be no match for the top one during the stretch, but continued on well to secure place honors. WONDER MAN underwent a five wide journey and held well enough to grab the show. SECRET DESIGN raced four wide and tired. CHEROKEE CRUE was no factor. UNLIKELY HERO away in good order, made the lead under his own courage, continued to show the way while racing off the inside, was tested by the top one nearing the quarter pole, succumbed without much resistance and steadily tired thereafter. OIL FIELD sluggish leaving the starting gate, was outrun.
