MEESE ROCKS sprinted clear on the rail, shook loose in upper stretch and drew off while being ridden out. BEBOBLUES ART gradually gained three wide on the turn and closed late to best the others. ESSEX FERRY pressed the pace in the two path and weakened. HOLD THE CRUISER checked at the half mile pole, saved ground on the turn and lacked a late response. VICARIOUS was outrun early after breaking slowly, circled four wide on the turn and lacked a further response. LAGNIAPPE was never a factor. OUR MONTANA DREAM saved ground and gave way on the turn.
