Footnotes

JUICY JACKLYN dueled along the inside for a half, opened a clear advantage in midstretch and was fully extended to hold off the runner-up under left hand urging. AVE. OF THE PINES was outrun while saving ground, angled out while gaining in upper stretch and finished well but could not get up. WANA PLAY stalked three wide for a half and lacked a strong closing response. RED HOOK BULLDOG pressed the winner between horses to the top of the stretch and tired. KELTIC FIGHTER never reached contention. MOM PROOF trailed after breaking slowly with the rider losing the whip while well back at the quarter pole.
