**Footnotes**

RAMBLING ROSE, unhurried while outrun early, put in a quick five wide move approaching the stretch, dug in gamely and prevailed under a drive. EVER AFTER, bumped at the start and rated along inside, angled out in upper stretch and finished gamely from the outside. CAPTIVE AUDIENCE raced with the pace while three wide, rallied to earn a clear lead in midstretch and stayed on well to the finish. SMOLDERING, bumped at the start, put in a three wide run on the second turn but had little left for the stretch drive. SILKS FOR DI broke awkwardly, contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. AFFIRM THE BID, rated along early, put in a run along the inside on the second turn but could not sustain that bid. CLASS OF FIFTY SIX bumped at the start, raced inside, came wide for the drive but lacked a rally. FIREMORE, rated inside, tired after the opening three quarters. MY JODI LYNN put in a four wide run on the second turn and tired in the stretch. THE PARTING GLASS was outrun. WELL GLORIA, bumped at the start, chased inside and tired badly. DAGMAR contested the pace for three quarters and stopped.
