SIRENUSE, unhurried early, came wide into the stretch, responded when roused and was going away late under a drive. PIB'S RUSH, hustled outside, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and continued on well to hold the place. SUSPENSE, bumped at the start, quickly showed in front, set the pace under constant pressure and weakened in the final furlong. OUT OF PLACE BELLE chased on the rail and had no rally. CHEROKEE RACER, bumped at the start, pressed the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. FEISTY K. C. A. C. chased three wide and tired. SMOOTH GOING bobbled at the start, chased the place while three wide and tired in the stretch. MARLA SUE was outrun. BUCKING THE TREND, bumped at the start, tired.
