LIVIN LARGE bumped at the start, readily advanced soon the incident to establish command, set the pace facing mild pressure from SOUTH FOURTH ST. while being kept off the inside, extended his advantage heading for the stretch, left the furlong grounds with his biggest lead, then needed steady encouragement during the final sixteenth to prevail. SOUTH FOURTH ST. prompted the pacesetter along the inside while placed under rating tactics during the initial five furlongs, was put to strong encouragement approaching the quarter pole, but failed to gain ground, angled outward with a furlong remaining, then closed gradually on the top one, but could not get there in time. PRETTY BOY FREUD was bumped at the start, sat well placed off the leaders while taking the three path, issued his bid for the lead approaching the top of the stretch, wasn't up to the task but held well to secure the show. HAMMOCK saved ground while placed under a firm hold, was taken to the outside in upper stretch, but lacked the necessary stretch response. DANTASTIC was no threat. SEPARATIST failed to menace. CORONATION DAY within striking distance, came four wide into the lane and tired.
