RYAN IS FLYING was outrun early, rallied wide on the second turn, dug in gamely in the stretch and was clear under the line, driving. EMOTRIN was unhurried early, rallied three wide on the second turn and stayed on to get the place prize. SEPTEMBER HERO contested the pace along the inside and stayed stubbornly on the rail. TOPSOIL KING was outrun early, raced three wide and lacked a rally. CANNONBALL ROCK raced wide throughout and had no rally. HUNTER'S TALE had no response when roused. SIR MANFRED was bumped after the start and had no rally. REBEL SONG contested the pace from the outside and tired. GOTTA BELIEVE stumbled at the start, was bumped and tired. TACTICAL STAN tired.
