MOOJAB was allowed to settle into stride, gradually advanced into contention along the inside on the turn, was taken outward midway on that bend, altered course to the outside soon after entering the stretch, commenced a strong rally once straightened away, took charge leaving eighth pole and drew off. ODYSSEUS bumped after the start, displayed a resolute rally to grab the place. KING ROCK within striking distance, was outfinished during the final furlong for the top two slots. LATIGO SHORE took the inside route, steadied while rank at the half mile pole, remained prominently placed, angled outward before commencing her bid approaching the quarter pole, split rivals, fought her way to a slim lead with a furlong remaining, but had nothing left to sustain her move. QUIESCENT HIT hustled to the lead, gave way after going five furlongs. POLITICAL AGENDA was no factor. STREETSOFBROOKLYN raced along the outside, was forced to steady when a rival took a bad step and stumbled during the run around the bend, had nothing left to offer after going a half. POSEIDON was bumped after the start, failed to reach a contending position. SABATINO prompted the pace, took a bad step and stumbled on the turn, faltered after a half. ROYAL STOCKS strung out four wide around the turn, tired.
