TAMPICO, rated along inside, got through along the rail all the way, spurted out to a clear lead nearing the eighth pole then dug in gamely and remained clear under a drive. IRISH DAISY, unhurried along the inside, saved ground into the stretch, angled out for running room in midstretch and finished fast from the outside. RUMPIPUMPY (GB) advanced inside on the second turn, came wide for the drive and stayed gamely to the finish. ST. BLAINE raced close up early while in hand, advanced outside on the second turn, gained a short lead between calls but weakened in the final yards. MISTY HOUR, rated along outside, raced wide and lacked a solid finishing punch. ABSOLUTELY QUEENIE was hustled to the front, opened a long lead on the backstretch then faltered in the stretch. ALL THE MOVES, taken back after the start, was no threat with a mild rally inside. KART STAR (IRE) raced between rivals and had no response when roused. AMERICAN DYNASTY chased the pace for three quarters and tired. NATALIE TOO raced wide and tired.
