BIJOU was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn and drew away late under a drive. WOODSIA was outrun early, put in a three wide run on the second turn, drew clear in the stretch, was no match for the winner and continued on to hold the place spot. LENTIL was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn and finished well outside. ALSTEMERIA (IRE) raced close up outside, put in a three wide run nearing the stretch and weakened in the drive. LAURIE BEGONE was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. GOLDEN GLIMMER chased the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. SPECTACULAR PLACE quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace for three quarters and gave way. AMERICA'S QUEEN was rated outside, raced three wide and tired in the stretch. TRUEYTOOT chased inside and tired. THREE PENNY OPERA raced close up while in hand, put in a run on the second turn and tired in the stretch.
